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Yemen Alert: PCC forces warn against travel on Marib, al-Jawf routes on September 7, avoid all travel

Current Situation:

- On September 7, Presidential Command Council's (PCC) Armed Forces spokesperson Brigadier General Majed al-Nuzaili warned civilians and motorists to avoid several roads connecting **Marib** and **al-Jawf** governorates until further notice, citing safety concerns.
- The advisory covers the following roads:
 - Naqil bin Ghaylan-Fardhah Naham-Jawf Junction-Madghal-Jawf Junction-Hazm al-Jawf
 - Juhannah-Sarwah-Marib
 - Qaniyah-Mahliyah-al-Jawbah-Marib
 - Al-Batinah-Hazm al-Jawf
 - Arhab-Sufyan-Hazm al-Jawf
- Authorities did not specify the nature of the threat or provide a timeframe for reopening the affected roads.

Recommendations:

1. Continue to avoid travel to Yemen at the current juncture, especially to Houthi-controlled territories and frontline areas amid elevated security risks due to the ongoing armed conflict.
2. In PCC-controlled areas, avoid all travel to airports, energy facilities, and ports in light of escalated tensions and the potential for Houthi attacks against these assets.
3. Those operating within Yemen are advised to avoid all travel to governorates with active frontlines between the Houthis and anti-Houthi forces, including Marib, al-Jawf, Bayda, Ibb, Dali, Taiz, and Hodeidah governorates, due to the persistent risk of armed conflict.
