




Greece Tactical: Pro-migration protest to take place at Syntagma Square in Athens at 18:30 (local time) on February 6; maintain heightened vigilance

Current Situation

- A pro-migration protest is slated to take place at Syntagma Square in Athens at 18:30 (local time) on February 6.
- The protest is being organized by a civil society group "Solidarity With Migrants" to denounce perceived racism and neo-colonial violence against migrants. Protesters will demand justice for those allegedly killed, imprisoned, and brutalized at borders and call for the abolition of restrictive immigration policies.

Assessments & Forecast

- 1. Based on the mobilization capabilities of the organizing group, coupled with social media estimates, the protest is likely to garner a turnout ranging in the high dozens to low hundreds.
- 2. Given the heightened sentiments associated with the protest issue, the protest carries a latent potential for unrest. This is also due to the potential participation of far-left activists. Although counter-protests have not previously occurred at demonstrations organized by the group, in the unlikely event of counterdemonstrations from anti-immigration or right-wing groups, clashes between protesters and the police, as well as with potential counter-protesters are likely.
- 3. As such, a bolstered security presence is likely to be deployed in the vicinity of the protest location as a precautionary measure. Disruptions to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic are likely in the vicinity of Syntagma Square during evening hours.

Recommendations

- 1. Those operating or residing in Athens on February 6 are advised to maintain heightened vigilance in the vicinity of Syntagma Square due to the potential for unrest at the protest.
- 2. Allot for associated travel disruptions from the evening hours onwards.
