Israel Tactical: Anti-government protest slated in Jerusalem, Tel Aviv on August 21, August 23; maintain heightened vigilance

Current Situation:

- Anti-government activists have called for protests in Jerusalem and Tel Aviv on August 21 and August 23.
- The protests call for a ceasefire deal that will ensure the release of the remaining Israeli hostages held in the Gaza Strip.

August 21

- Activists called for a sit-in in front of the government complex on Kaplan Street in Jerusalem at 19:00 (local time), coinciding with a cabinet meeting.

August 23

- Multiple left-wing groups have called for a protest march, calling for the end of the war, from Tel Aviv's Dizengoff Square toward HaBima Square at 16:30.
- The Hostages' Families Forum called for a demonstration at Tel Aviv's Hostages' Square at 20:00.
- Additionally, the Hostages' Families Forum called for a demonstration at Jerusalem's Paris Square at 21:15.
