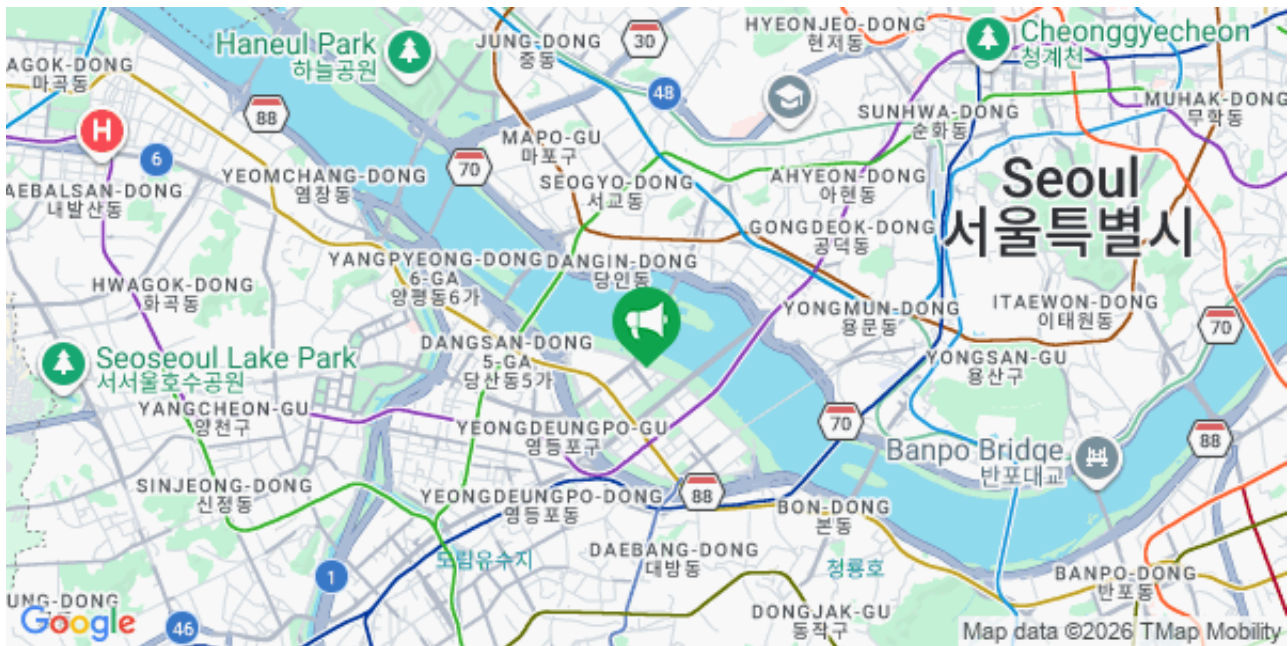

South Korea Tactical: Protest slated in front of Yeouido Full Gospel Church in Seoul from 07:00-15:00 (local time) on May 3; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- Activists are slated to hold a rally in front of Seoul's Yeouido Full Gospel Church from 07:00-15:00 (local time) on May 3.
- The protest aims to denounce Pastor Lee Young-hoon's alleged political involvement with government figures and state affairs, including what organizers describe as inappropriate lobbying and engagement with political power.

Assessments & Forecast:

The turnout at the slated gathering is likely to range between the low-to-mid dozens, based on the resonance of the issue. The authorities are likely to heighten security measures in the vicinity of Yeouido Full Gospel Church, particularly given the location's proximity to the National Assembly building. These measures are likely to include the deployment of police personnel and setting up barricades to monitor the proceedings. The gathering is anticipated to transpire peacefully, given its symbolic nature. Localized disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular travel are anticipated due to the expected turnout and related security measures during the protest hours on May 3.

Recommendations:

Those operating or residing in Seoul on May 3 are advised to allot for travel disruptions in the vicinity of the Yeouido Full Gospel Church due to the slated protest and associated security measures.
