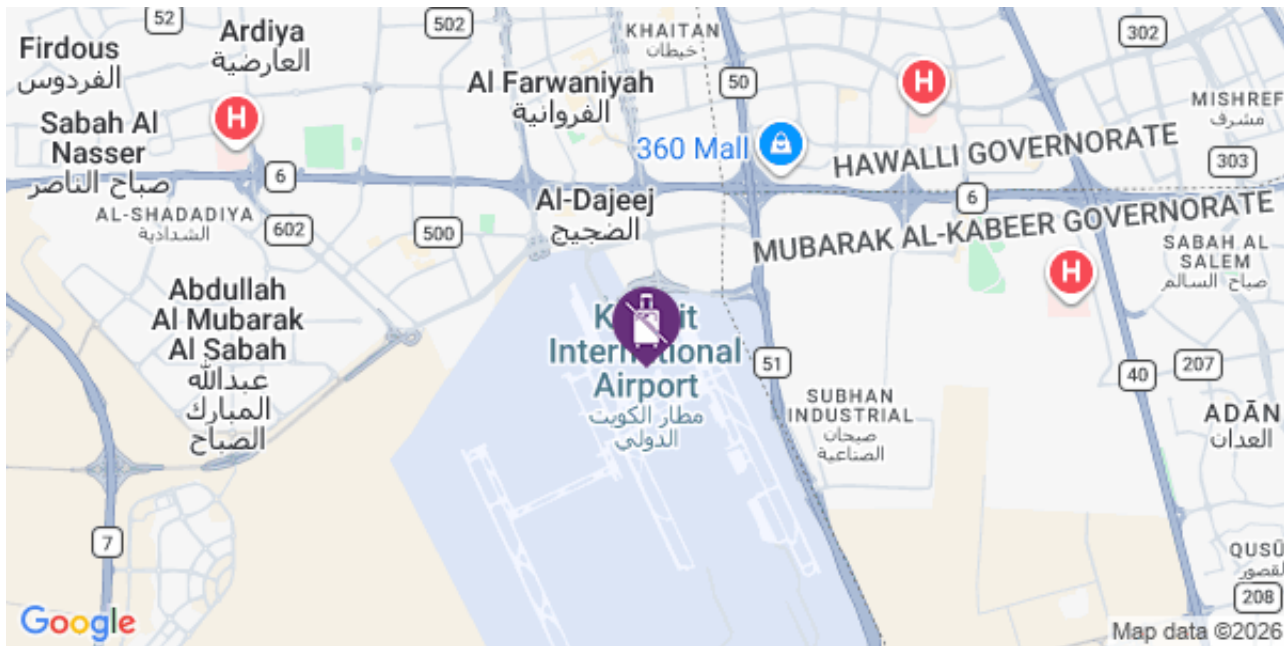

Kuwait Alert (UPDATE): Authorities announce return to normal air traffic after temporary closure during morning hours of June 11; continue avoiding all travel

Current Situation:

- Kuwait's Directorate General of Civil Aviation announced the reopening of its airspace and return to normal air traffic operations following Iranian strikes during the early morning hours (local time) on June 11.
- Authorities confirmed a full return to normal operational activity at the Kuwait International Airport (KWI) and the resumption of flights.
- The Directorate confirmed that it is closely monitoring the situation to ensure safety and security in its airspace, calling on travelers to follow official channels for the latest updates.
