

Iran Tactical: Nationwide earthquake drill slated at Tehran's Velayat Park on February 20; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- Iranian authorities have announced a 10,000-person "earthquake maneuver" at **Tehran's Velayat Park** at unspecified hours of February 20.
- The exercise is set to include 51 simulated military rescue operations, such as airlifting hypothetical casualties.
- Around 110 organizations and agencies will participate, with Velayat Park divided into several zones to simulate field hospital setups, rubble removal, hazardous material (HAZMAT) management, and casualty evacuation.
- Iranian state-linked media indicated that the drills may lead to domestic flight delays at Tehran airports, including **Mehrabad International Airport**, roughly eight kilometers northwest of Velayat Park.
- Authorities have advised passengers to reach the airport at least 1.5 hours before their flights.
