MENA Tactical: Pro-Palestinian protests slated in Jordan, Turkey on February 6-7; maintain heightened vigilance

## **Current Situation:**

- Pro-Palestinian activists have called for protests in Jordan and Turkey on February 6-7 to express solidarity with Palestinians and condemn US President Donald Trump's recent remarks about the US "takeover of the Gaza Strip."
- In **Turkey**, activists from the "Anatolian Youth Association in Istanbul" (AGD) have called for a demonstration in front of the US Consulate in Istanbul at 22:00 (local time) on February 6.
- In **Jordan**, the "National Forum for Supporting the Resistance and Protecting the Homeland" has called for a protest march at Amman's Grand Husseini Mosque on February 7 after Friday afternoon prayers.
