India Tactical: Traffic restrictions in effect for religious event at Shree Khatu Shyam Mandir in Delhi until November 2; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- A traffic advisory issued by the Delhi Traffic Police (DTP) remains in effect due to a religious event at the Shree Khatu Shyam Mandir on Grand Trunk Karnal Road in Delhi until November 2.
- The authorities anticipate a gathering of approximately 800,000 to 1 million devotees at the site, leading to heavy pedestrian movement and potential traffic congestion in surrounding areas.
- The travelers are advised to avoid vehicular movement on National Highway (NH) 44 between the Singhu Border and Mukarba Chowk until November 2.
- The DTP also announced potential traffic diversions at the Singhu Border and Bakoli on Urban Extension Road (UER)-II on the days.
- The DTP has also advised commuters to use UER-II Road or Palla Bakhtawarpur Road as an alternate routes for the duration of the advisory.
