Iran Tactical: March to commemorate 'National Day of Struggle Against Global Arrogance' to be held in Tehran during morning hours on November 4; maintain heightened vigilance

Current Situation:

- According to state-affiliated media, the Islamic Development Coordination Council announced that a march will be held in Tehran from 09:00 (local time) on November 4 on occasion of the "National Day of Struggle Against Global Arrogance."
- This date marks the anniversary of the November 4, 1979, storming of the US Embassy in Tehran by Iranian students and the ensuing hostage crisis.
- The march will proceed from Palestine Square to the former US Embassy on Taleqani Street.
- Similar marches and commemorative events will be held throughout the country.

Recommendations:

- 1. Those operating or residing in Tehran during the morning hours on November 4 are advised to maintain heightened vigilance and allot for travel disruptions due to the slated march.
- 2. Remain cognizant of similar events planned nationwide on November 4.
- 3. Western nationals are advised to maintain a low profile in public and avoid revealing their identities and political affiliations, given the anti-US and Western nature of the event.
